(*PMI 2005) Earned Value Management Methodology can help you answer these questions!

President's Corner by Bob Sanders, PMP

I hope everyone enjoyed their Holiday's with family and friends and are ready to begin a new year. I am very excited about working with this year's PMI Eastern Iowa Leadership volunteers. We will meet for the first time as a group on January 21st to set goals and objectives for 2006 and to develop a roadmap so we can successfully accomplish them.

Last year was a very busy and productive year. I would like to thank the 2005 PMI Eastern Iowa Board for their dedication and hard work as a volunteer. In 2005, membership grew, financials were strong, and many individual and group accomplishments were achieved. The following information was presented at our Annual Business Meeting in December and I wanted to share it with all of our membership to show how your elected volunteers respectfully served you last year:

Membership (As of November 2005)

- 255 Members (19.2% increase)
- 133 PMP's (84.7% increase)
- Top Companies by Count:
 - Pearson 102 (14.6% increase)
 - Rockwell Collins 21 (50% increase)
 - Intermec 15 (15.4% increase)
 - Aegon 14 (180% increase)
 - Iowa Health Systems 5
 - Perot Systems 5 (150% increase)

Financials (As of November 2005)

- Exceeding income by 15%
- Spent only 55% of planned budget
- On pace to have a positive revenue vs. a planned negative revenue
- Improved cash flow by 12.4%
