Pipeline Planning and Resource Pool Management Using MS Project

Course Description:

Pipeline Planning and Resource Management using MS Project: This course is designed to instruct Project Managers on techniques to manage project resources, pipelines, and multiple projects using Microsoft ® Project's more powerful capabilities. The class demonstrates how those capabilities can be used to transform resource management concepts into your Microsoft ® project schedule. The class is instructor led and includes many hands-on labs. The topics covered in "Pipeline Planning and Resource Management using MS Project" are as follows:

- · Skills assessment, Team Development, and Resource Assigning
- Resource Leveling, Over-allocation, and Resource Inefficiencies
- Developing and Managing Resource Pools
- Master Project Development, Project Pipeline Development

Learning Objectives: Master many of the more powerful features of Microsoft ® Project. Each student will understand the concepts necessary to manage project resources and the project pipeline. Though a series of very helpful "hands on" labs, participants will gain insights into how to Microsoft ® Project 'thinks' about resource allocation and leveling. Attendees who are Project Management Professionals (PMP) will receive 4 Professional Development Unit credits with the PMI under category 4.
