Our chapter PMPs should review the Continuing Certification Requirements to correctly post their prior years' eligible activities for Professional Development Unit (PDU) credits. The following text is excerpted from the PMI Global website as a reminder to the Continuing Certification Requirements program.

What is the Continuing Certification Requirements program?

The PMI Continuing Certification Requirements program (CCR) supports the ongoing educational and professional development of individuals who have attained the PMP and/or PgMP credential(s), hereafter referred to as "certificants". The purpose of the CCR program is to:

- Enhance the ongoing professional development of certificants
- Encourage and recognize individualized learning opportunities
- Offer a standardized and objective mechanism for attaining and recording professional development activities, and
- Sustain the global recognition and value of PMI's credentials

A PDUs Reminder To Our Chapter's PMPs...

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In order to satisfy the CCR Program and maintain an active credential status individuals who have attained the PMP and/or Program Management Professional credential(s) must accrue and report a minimum of 60 professional development units (PDUs) during each CCR cycle, which is typically 3 years, complete an Application for Certification Renewal and payment of the renewal fee, and reaffirm PMI's Code of Professional Conduct.

How do you keep your certifications current?

You can be certain that PMI's credentials will maintain their prestigious standing worldwide. This is due in part to PMI's tireless commitment to enforcing the highest standards and practices of its credentialed members. The Continued Certification Requirements (CCR) program is a vital part of that commitment. It ensures that individuals holding the PMP and/or PgMP credential demonstrate ongoing commitment to professional growth and development, a criterion of all high-end professional organizations.

Requirements and procedures for the Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) program are outlined in the CCR Program Handbook, which is available on the PMI Global website - www.pmi.org.

PDU University Series

Introduction to Project Management Workshop

Course Description:

Introduction to Project Management Workshop: The class introduces and provides participants a detailed understanding of the project management framework and concepts including the project management process areas, and the 9 knowledge areas. It details organizational structures and leadership / management principles necessary to form the project team. Participants will "understand through use" all 44 project management processes through a series of class exercises and case studies. Participants will initiate, plan, execute, control, and close a project plan. They will perform scenario based integration management with scope, time, cost, and quality management. They will understand how resource management best practices must be in place for a project team to function successfully. Participants will review the professional responsibility domain, code of conduct, and cultural sensitivity in International Project Management. Repeated use of scenario based project management cost formulas will ensure that participants have much more than a "classroom" understanding of these foundational costing methods. Participants will also have a "hands on" understanding of critical path.

Learning Objectives: Understand the breadth of Project Management! Each student will understand the concepts necessary to formally manage projects and pursue the Project Management Professional certification. Attendees who are Project Management Professionals (PMPs) will receive 4 Professional Development Unit (PDU) credits with the PMI under category 4. For those who are not PMP certified, this class carries 4 Contact Credit hours with the PMI.
