Skilled project managers are in demand around the world. A globally recognized project management certification shows employers that you have the knowledge, experience, and education to effectively contribute to project team success.

Credential	Description	Certification Cycle	PDUs Required
CAPM [®]	The CAPM certification recognizes a demonstrated understanding of the fundamental knowledge, processes and terminology as defined in the PMBOK® Guide that are needed for effective project management performance.	5 years	No PDUs. Re-exam at end of five-year cycle
PMP®	The PMP certification recognizes competence of an individual to perform in the role of a project manager, specifically experience in leading and directing projects.	3 years	60
PgMP [®]	The PgMP certification recognizes demonstrated experience, skill and performance in the oversight of multiple, related projects that are aligned with organizational objectives.	3 years	60
PMI-ACP SM	The PMI-ACP certification validates a practitioner's ability to understand and apply agile principles and practices on basic projects. The PMI-ACP carries a high level of credibility as it requires a combination of agile training, experience working on agile projects and examination on agile practices of project management.	3 years	30 PDUs in agile principles and practices
PMI-RMP®	The PMI-RMP certification recognizes demonstrated knowledge and expertise in the specialized area of assessing and identifying project risks along with plans to mitigate threats and capitalize on opportunities.	3 years	30 PDUs in specialized area of project risk management
PMI-SP®	The PMI-SP certification recognizes demonstrated knowledge and expertise in the specialized area of developing and maintaining the project schedule.	3 years	30 PDUs in specialized area of project scheduling
