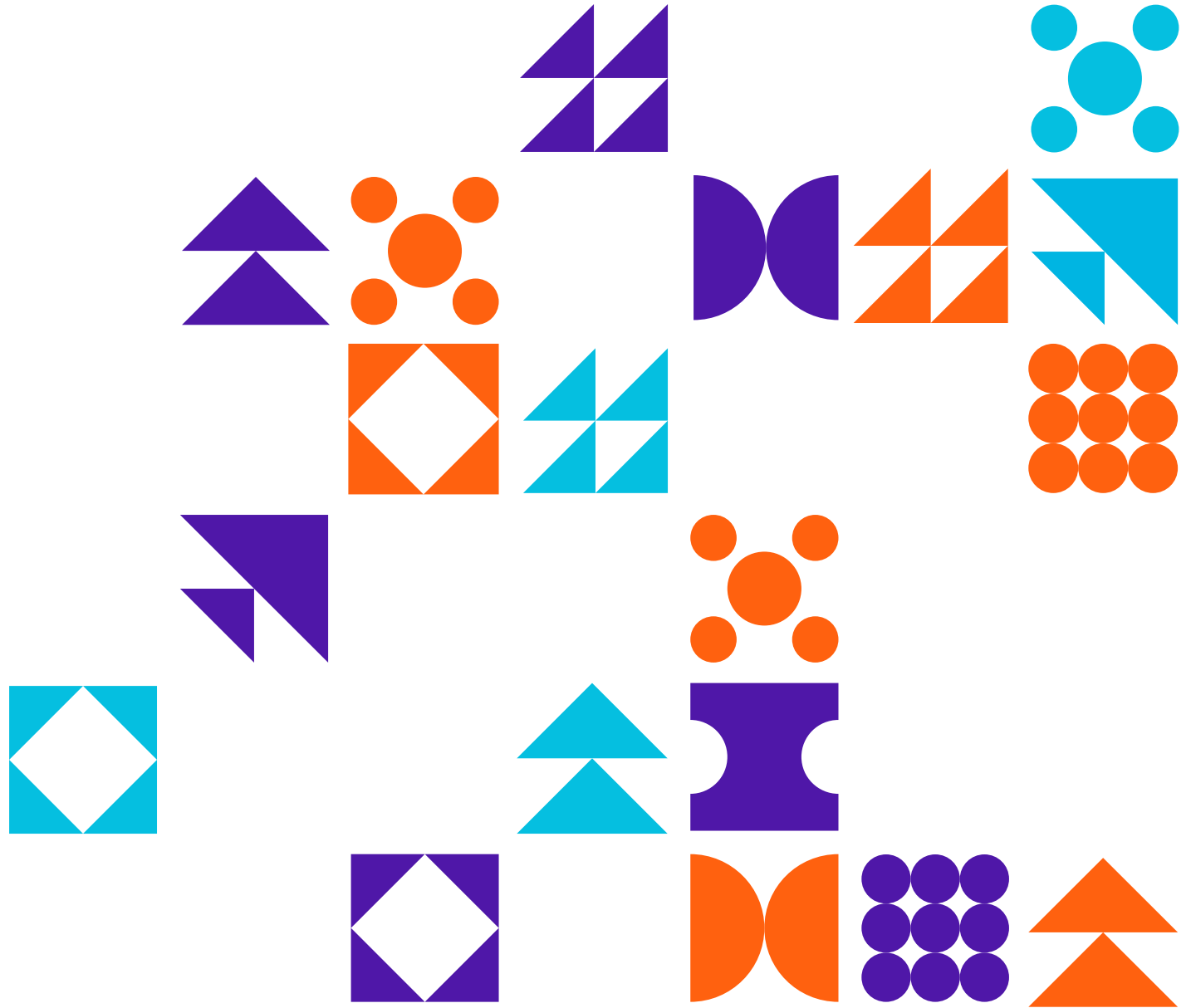

## Saeko VonBehren, PMP®

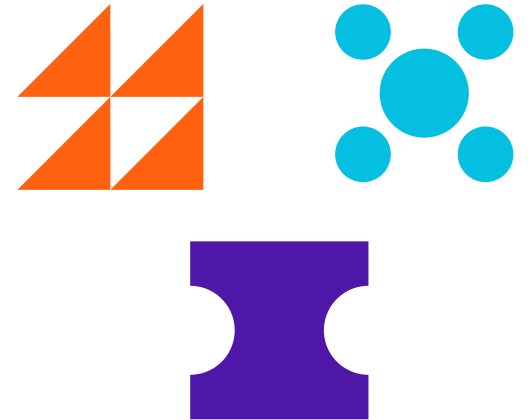

## Bob Sanders, PMP®

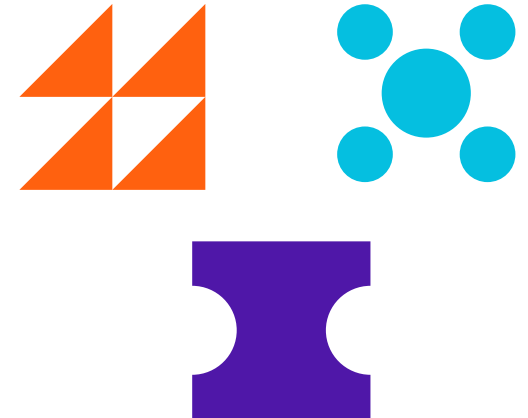

**Jenn Lohrer, PMP®**

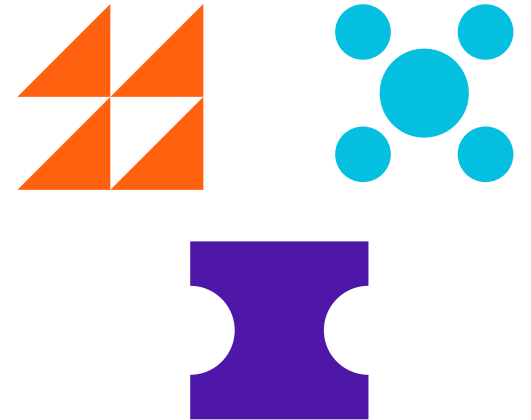
Jenn earned her PMP in January of 2018 and has been a PMI Eastern Iowa Chapter member since 2017. She has over 20 years of leadership and project management experience.

# Vice President of Education

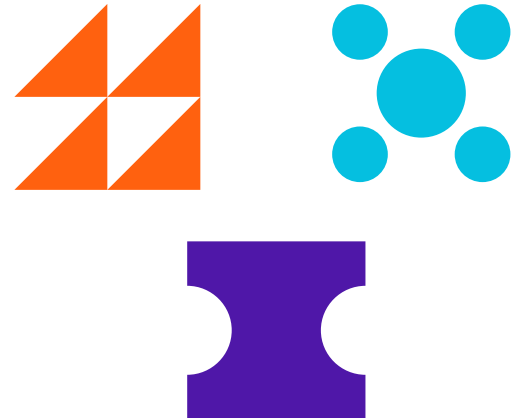
**Robert Musetescu, PMP®**

**Brian Tompkins, PMP®**

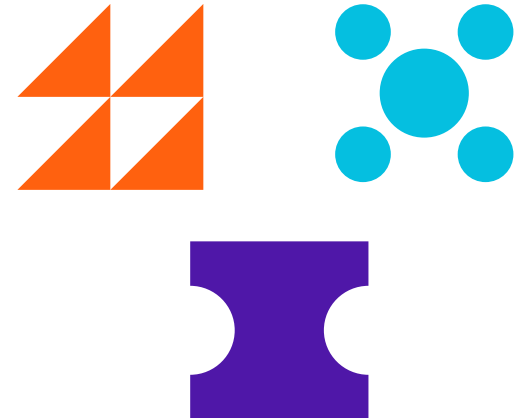
Brian brings over 20 years of technology experience, working across numerous industries, including retail, educational assessment, finance/insurance and science/research.

# Vice President of Outreach

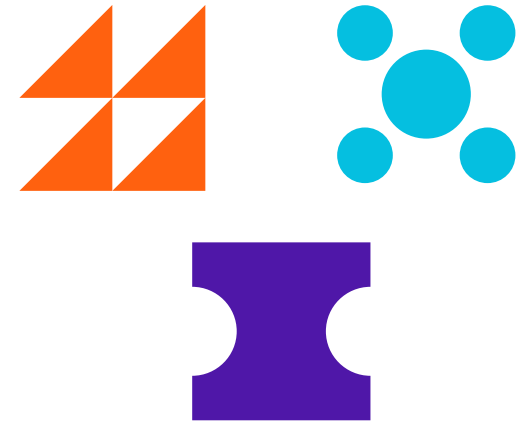
**Nadya Garey-Thompson, PMP®**
